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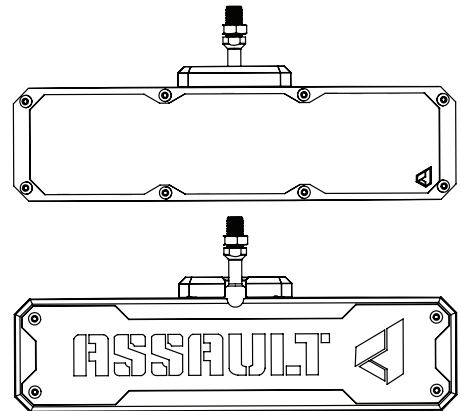


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

AI-RVM-U-BOMB-1.5"-2": BOMBER CONVEX CENTER MIRROR

⚠ BE SURE TO READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND ILLUSTRATIONS BEFORE STARTING.

⚠ DO NOT DISCARD PACKAGING UNTIL PRODUCT HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY INSTALLED.

- ⚠ HEX KEYS: 2.5, 4, 5MM
- ⚠ CLEAN TOWEL

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The Bomber Convex Center Mirror is held together with a series of hex head screws. The process of assembly is straight forward and simple but there are some things to note about changing bezels or replacing glass.

1. Any screws removed from the housing or bezels should be placed together with the other screws from the same area just to ensure that everything goes back where it came from.
2. **Re-installation of rear bezels** - Ensure the orientation of the bezel is correct (not backwards) and install screws finger tight. The surface where the mirror is placed should be free of any objects that could potentially crack the glass while working on the back panel.
3. **Re-installation of glass and front bezel** - The glass must be installed in a specific way and very carefully so that it does not crack.
 - A. With the mirror laying flat on a towel, place the mirror glass on the housing body with the etched logo in the lower right corner.
 - B. Inspect the bezel for burrs that can cause damage to the glass during install.
 - C. Place the bezel over the glass and align with holes in the housing.
 - D. Grab 4 screws and hand thread the 4 center screws, then use the hex key to thread close to the bezel but not tightened. The bezel should still have some movement.
 - E. Grab 2 screws and carefully press down on one of the outer sides of the bezel and hand thread the screws. Repeat for the opposite side.
 - F. Use the hex key to "snug" - not tighten - the screws on the outer edges of the mirror.
 - G. Using your finger, nudge the glass to see if it moves around under the bezel, if it does you will want to carefully snug the 4 center screws until there is very little gap between the screw cap and the bezel. Over-tightening the center screws can put too much tension on the glass resulting in the possibility for cracks.

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
